

MINUTES of the CITY OF MILO COUNCIL MEETING
CITY HALL, 100 MAIN ST, MILO, IOWA – MONDAY, FEBRUARY 15, 2021

Milo City Council was called to order by Mayor Hall at 7:01 p.m. Mayor Hall then administered the Council Oath of Office to Erica Wadle and seated her in the vacant council position. Council answering roll call: Moulds, Wadle, Uttley and Mason. Kinser was absent. The Pledge of Allegiance was administered.

Motion by Mason to approve the consent agenda including all council meeting minutes of February 1, 2021; accounts payable from February 2 - 15, 2021 in the amount of \$17,186.58; and Resolution 2021-05 Acknowledging the Appointment of Erica Wadle to the vacated council seat. Motion approved. Mayor Hall called for public comment and hearing none closed the public hearing with a motion by Moulds. Second by Uttley. Ayes: Moulds, Wadle, Uttley, and Mason. Nays: none. Absent: Kinser. Motion approved. Next, motion by Mason to approve the Milo FY2022 Maximum Tax Levy. Second by Uttley. Ayes: Moulds, Wadle, Uttley, and Mason. Nays: none. Absent: Kinser. Motion approved.

Old business, Mayor Hall stated there was not any new information to offer on the wastewater update. Mayor then noted that Clint Bailey's acquaintance would be calling Doug Hembry regarding the ballfield lighting.

After review of new business, Mayor Hall read Ordinance 2021-01 Urban Chickens and then a motion by Moulds to approve the first reading of Ordinance 2021-01 Urban Chickens. Second Mason. Ayes: Moulds, Wadle, Uttley, and Mason. Nays: none. Absent: Kinser. Motion approved. Then, a motion by Moulds to waive the 2nd and 3rd readings of Ordinance 2021-01 Urban Chickens. Second by Mason. Ayes: Moulds, Wadle, Uttley, and Mason. Nays: none. Absent: Kinser. Motion approved. After review, motion by Moulds to approve the Milo FY2022 City Budget and set for hearing on March 15, 2021 during the Milo City Council Meeting. Second by Mason. Ayes: Moulds, Wadle, Uttley, and Mason. Nays: none. Absent: Kinser. Motion approved.

There were no public comments and no propositions and remarks were heard. Health and Safety Meeting reviewed ethics information for elected officials. Motion by Moulds to adjourn at 7:18 p.m. Second by Mason. Ayes: all present. Motion approved.
