

MINUTES of the CITY OF MILO COUNCIL MEETING  
CITY HALL, MILO, IOWA – MONDAY, MARCH 21, 2022

Milo City Council was called to order by Mayor Hall at 7:00 p.m. Council answering the Clerk's roll call: Wadle, Rasmussen, Uttley and Mason. The Pledge of Allegiance was administered. Kinser arrived at 7:01 p.m.

Motion by Mason to approve the agenda. Second by Wadle. Ayes: Kinser, Wadle, Rasmussen, Mason and Uttley. Nays: none. Motion approved. Motion by Wadle to approve the consent agenda to include all council meeting minutes of March 7, 2022; accounts payable from March 8 - 21, 2022, in the amount of \$23,883.94; February 2022 Warren County Sheriff's Report. Second by Mason. Ayes: Kinser, Wadle, Rasmussen, Mason and Uttley. Nays: none. Motion approved.

Mayor Hall opened the Fy2023 Milo City Budget Public Hearing with a motion by Kinser and second by Mason. Ayes: Kinser, Wadle, Rasmussen, Mason and Uttley. Nays: none. Motion approved. Mayor Hall called for public comment, hearing none. Mayor Hall asked City Clerk for any written comments, Clerk replied there were no written comments submitted. Mayor Hall then closed the public hearing with a motion by Wadle and second by Mason. Next, a motion was made by Kinser to approve Resolution 2022-09 approving the Fy2023 Milo City Budget and directing the City Clerk to make the necessary filings. Second by Mason. Roll call vote: Ayes: Kinser, Wadle, Rasmussen, Mason and Uttley. Nays: none. Motion approved.

Hall Engineering and ISG Inc. will meet with Mayor Hall, Doug Hembry and City Clerk to review wastewater update information and mapping for the upcoming construction. City Clerk shared that the State Revolving Fund Planning and Design Loan has been approved. Next, reviewing the draft of the UTV ordinance a motion by Mason to approve the UTV Ordinance draft and direct the City Clerk to set the first reading for the next council meeting. Second by Kinser. Ayes: Kinser, Wadle, Rasmussen, Mason and Uttley. Nays: none. Motion approved.

Council reviewed new business items with the following actions: Motion by Kinser to approve a portable building permit for 525 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, Milo, Iowa. Second by Wadle. Ayes: Kinser, Wadle, Rasmussen, Mason and Uttley. Nays: none. Motion approved.

There were no public comments. City Clerk shared that several letters have been sent to citizens for yard debris and junk vehicles. City Clerk shared information regarding two pending vacant property sales.

Council discussed roaming dogs and asked that the ordinance be reviewed at the next city council meeting. Mayor Hall shared that Hometown Pride's Souper Bingo brought in over \$2,000.
