MINUTES of the CITY OF MILO COUNCIL MEETING

CITY HALL, MILO, IOWA - MONDAY, MAY 15, 2023

Milo City Council was called to order by Mayor Hall who joined telephonically at 7:33 p.m. and noted that Council had achieved a quorum and that the Clerk was absent. Council answering the Mayor's roll call: Kinser, Wadle and Uttley. Absent: Rasmussen and Mason. Mayor Hall administered the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Kinser and second by Uttley to approve the amended agenda to remove item 7, noting that Crystal McIntyre will attend a future meeting due to the late start of the meeting. Ayes: Kinser, Wadle and Uttley. Nays: none. Absent: Rasmussen and Mason. Motion approved.

Motion by Wadle and second by Uttley to approve the consent agenda to include all Council meeting minutes of May 5, 2023; accounts payable from May 2 - May 15, 2023, in the amount of \$7,982.90; April 2023 bank reconciliation report; April 2023 Warren County Sheriff's Report. Ayes: Kinser, Wadle and Uttley. Nays: none. Absent: Rasmussen and Mason. Motion approved.

Mayor Hall opened the public hearing for the fy2023 Milo city budget amendment upon a motion by Kinser and second by Uttley. Roll call vote: Ayes: Kinser, Wadle and Uttley. Nays: none. Absent: Rasmussen and Mason. Motion approved. Mayor Hall asked for public comments and Kinser stated there was no public present. Mayor Hall stated that the Clerk had previously informed her that no written comments were received. Mayor Hall closed the public hearing upon a motion by Wadle and second by Kinser. Roll call vote: Ayes: Kinser, Wadle and Uttley. Nays: none. Absent: Rasmussen and Mason. Motion approved. Then, motion by Wadle and second by Uttley to approve Resolution 2023-17 approving the fy2023 Milo city budget amendment and directing the Clerk to make the necessary filings. Roll call vote: Ayes: Kinser, Wadle and Uttley. Nays: none. Absent: Rasmussen and Mason. Motion approved.

Under old business, there was no new information for the Wastewater Treatment Facility Improvement Project. The North Trail Connector concrete was tabled to obtain bids.

Under new business, Council reviewed all items resulting in the following actions: Motion by Wadle and second by Uttley to approve Casey's General Store tobacco permit. Ayes: Kinser, Wadle and Uttley. Nays: none. Absent: Rasmussen and Mason. Motion approved. Then, motion by Uttley to approve the

Warren Water District's water service request for 19691 McKinley Street, Milo, Iowa. Parcel# 03000060868. Second by Kinser. Ayes: Kinser, Wadle and Uttley. Nays: none. Absent: Rasmussen and Mason. Motion approved. Then, Council tabled the street closing request for the Eric Ohnemus Car Show to the next meeting to obtain more information. Councilwoman Wadle was concerned with the street map not coinciding with the written text of the application; and of concern is the church services nearby on July 2, 2023 and the location of the registration; residents can still navigate out of their driveways. Next, motion by Uttley second by Wadle to approve the tax abatement application for 705 Belmont Street, Milo, Iowa. Ayes: Kinser, Wadle and Uttley. Nays: none. Absent: Rasmussen and Mason. Motion approved. Next, motion by Uttley and second by Kinser to approve the demolition permit for 409 2nd Street, Milo, Iowa. Ayes: Kinser, Wadle and Uttley. Nays: none. Absent: Rasmussen and Mason. Motion approved. Public inquired via Councilwoman Wadle that the trail edges behind the upper ballfield needs mowed and asked who would be mowing it. Uttley stated that at a previous meeting it was decided that Doug Hembry would mow because the City has a mower and it would be only along the edges of trail. Mayor Hall will check this and report back at the next meeting. Mayor Hall then shared that the 2 grants were awarded from Warren County Philanthropic Partnership in the amount of \$5,000 for the storm siren and \$5,000 for the north electronic reader board project. Mayor Hall stated that she is still waiting for the announcement of the Prairie Meadows grant which will happen in July. Mayor Hall also shared that Milo Hometown Pride will be conducting a pole banner contest for the future pole banners in Milo. Information is the Milo and Hometown Pride Facebook pages. Motion by Wadle and second by Uttley to adjourn at 7:47 p.m. Ayes: All present. Motion approved.

City Government 2023 Election

Do you have some really great ideas for improving the City of Milo? Do you see a street issue or a park issue that needs addressed? Maybe you would like to improve Main Street or help bring a new business to town? Then City Council is for you!

This is an election year for Milo and on November 7, 2023 citizens of Milo will vote and elect three people to serve our community as members of city government; 2 council seats and 1 mayoral seat. If you want to be one of those people, find the candidacy information you need at www.sos.iowa.gov and click on the election tab or stop by City Hall for a paper copy.

All candidates and incumbents must file the appropriate paperwork with the Milo City Clerk at 100 Main Street, Milo, Iowa. The deadline for filing candidacy papers at the office of the Milo City Clerk is between August 28 - September 21, 2023 at 5:00 p.m.

If preferred the nomination petition and affidavit of candidacy may be filed with the Warren County Auditor, 301 North Buxton Street, Suite #101, Indianola, Iowa.

Milo Sewer Rate Increase

The Milo City Council, after holding a public hearing and 3 separate readings of the proposed ordinance, has approved residential and commercial sewer rate increases effective with the July 1, 2023 utility bill. The \$10 increase per customer will apply to the minimum usage of up to 3,000 gallons of sewer; rates for gallons used over 3,000 will remain the same. The resulting monthly sewer rate will be \$62.00 per customer. This is required to pay for the impending wastewater facility improvements required by the Iowa Department of Natural Resources.

The water, sewer and garbage utilities have to be operationally self-sufficient, meaning that no property tax dollars are used to support the utility system.

The City has diligently pursued different avenues of funding since notice of the required wastewater facility improvements began in 2014. The voter's approval in 2015 of the Local Option Sales Tax, brings in an average of \$60,000 annually which has been designated to this improvement. The City has also invested revenue income funds for this purpose and continues to look for grants and other sources to lighten the financial burden on citizens.

Milo Hometown Pride

Milo Hometown Pride is pleased to have received the Warren County Master Gardener Mini-Grant for \$500. Grants provide financial support and master gardener assistance for community gardens and landscape beautification projects throughout Warren County. Hometown Pride used the funds for additional shrubs, flowers and mulch in the gardens at Centennial Park. Master Gardener Sue Thompson mentored the project while our third graders planted the flowers they had grown from seeds in their classroom. FFA students assisted with clean-up, planting and mulching. These enhancements will increase the enjoyment of the park, playground and ball field visitors.



Every digging project requires a call to 811. Hitting an underground utility line can harm the environment, cause serious personal injuries, disrupt service to an entire neighborhood and potentially incur fines and repair costs. Some common examples of when to call 811 are: installing a rural mailbox, putting up a fence, planting trees or shrubbery, building a patio or deck, excavating a new garden area, etc.

City of Milo Ordinance 135.08 BURNING PROHIBITED. "No person shall burn any trash, leaves, rubbish or other combustible material....". City of Milo Ordinance 105.05 OPEN BURNING RESTRICTED. "No person shall allow, cause or permit open burning of combustible materials...". The complete ordinance is available at www.cityofmilo.com/government.

The Milo City Dump, located at the south edge of Milo, is open for citizens to use. Note that the only items allowed in the City Dump are concrete, dirt and yard vegetation (including trees) – please be sure to follow the posted guidelines! Absolutely no treated lumber, building materials, or trash!






