

MINUTES of the CITY OF MILO COUNCIL MEETING  
CITY HALL, 100 MAIN ST, MILO, IOWA – TUESDAY, MAY 28, 2024

Milo City Council was called to order by Mayor Hall at 7:00 p.m. City Council answering the Clerk's roll call: Kinser, Wadle, Griggs, and Mason. Rasmussen was absent. Mayor Hall administered the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Kinser, second Mason to approve the agenda with the addition of 7.e. Milo Trail Change Order from Elder Corporation. Ayes: Kinser, Wadle, Griggs, and Mason. Nays: none. Absent: Rasmussen. Motion approved.

Motion by Wadle, second by Mason to open the public hearing for fy2024 Milo city budget amendment. Roll call vote: Ayes: Kinser, Wadle, Griggs, and Mason. Nays: none. Absent: Rasmussen. Motion approved. Mayor Hall called for oral comments and heard none. Mayor asked the Clerk for any written comments, clerk said there were none. Motion by Wadle, second by Griggs to close the public hearing. Roll call vote: Ayes: Kinser, Wadle, Griggs, and Mason. Nays: none. Absent: Rasmussen. Motion approved. Motion by Mason, second by Kinser to approve Resolution 2024-09 approving the Fy2024 Milo city budget amendment. Roll call vote: Ayes: Kinser, Wadle, Griggs, and Mason. Nays: none. Absent: Rasmussen. Motion approved.

Council reviewed all old business items resulting in the following information/actions: Motion by Kinser, second by Wadle to approve wastewater project change order 13 due to a delayed delivery of an electrical component. Ayes: Kinser, Wadle, Griggs, and Mason. Nays: none. Absent: Rasmussen. Motion approved. Then regarding the trail, motion by Mason, second by Griggs to approve the trail project contract payment 2 to Elder Corporation in the amount of \$123,906.85. Next, motion by Griggs, second by Wadle to approve the US Cellular/Smith Fertilizer & Grain Monopole Cellular Tower and building pending the Milo Board of Adjustments determination of approved height. Ayes: Kinser, Wadle, Griggs, and Mason. Nays: none. Absent: Rasmussen. Motion approved. After, motion by Griggs, second by Mason to approve allowing a Farmer's Market to be held at City Park on Sunday afternoons and noting that there will be certain times that the park will not be available due to community events or rentals. Ayes: Kinser, Wadle, Griggs, and Mason. Nays: none. Absent: Rasmussen. Motion approved. Then, Doug Hembry, Maintenance Director, presented a bid to fix a curb/gutter issue on Main Street his request resulted in a motion by Mason, second by Kinser to approve Pride Concrete's bid of \$4,500 to repair curb/gutter along 120 Main Street from the entrance to the business west to the stop sign. The cost will be paid out of Road Use Tax funds. Ayes: Kinser, Wadle, Griggs, and Mason. Nays: none. Absent: Rasmussen. Motion approved.

Council reviewed all new business items resulting in the following information/actions: Mayor Hall administered the second reading of the ordinances listed. Then, motion by Kinser, second by Griggs to approve the second reading of Ordinance 2024-01 Milo Code Chapter 65 Stop or Yield Required and to waive the 3<sup>rd</sup> reading. Roll call vote: Ayes: Kinser, Wadle, Griggs, and Mason. Nays: none. Absent: Rasmussen. Motion approved. Then, motion by Griggs, second by Mason to approve the second reading of Ordinance 2024-02 Milo Code Chapter 69 Parking Regulations and to waive the 3<sup>rd</sup> reading. Roll call vote: Ayes: Kinser, Wadle, Griggs, and Mason. Nays: none. Absent: Rasmussen. Motion approved. Next, motion by Griggs, second by Kinser to approve the second reading of Ordinance 2024-03 Milo Code Chapter 106 Collection of Solid Waste and to set the 3<sup>rd</sup> reading for June 3, 2024. Roll call vote: Ayes: Kinser, Wadle, Griggs, and Mason. Nays: none. Absent: Rasmussen. Motion approved. Motion by Kinser, second by Griggs to approve the trail project Change Order 2 from McClure Engineering and Elder Corporation. Ayes: Kinser, Wadle, Griggs, and Mason. Nays: none. Absent: Rasmussen. Motion approved.

Motion by Mason second by Wadle to adjourn at 7:34 p.m. Ayes: All present. Motion approved.
